- 1. Entry will be open to current members of the Helena USBC Youth. Bowlers participating in Adult USBC leagues are not eligible.
- 2. Teams will consist of 4 boys, 4 girls, or a mixed combination may be used. Mixed doubles will be allowed.
- 3. Three games will be bowled in all Divisions (A & B). Bantams will bowl 2 game events, unless they choose to bowl in three game divisions. Each event will be bowled on a separate pair of lanes. Bowlers bowling in Doubles must bowl in Singles, and vice versa. No bowler may compete more than once in Doubles / Singles event. A bowler may bowl Team Event more than once, but their first time bowled in this event will count for All-Events. A team must change at least 2 bowlers to bowl a Team Event again. Competition during league play only can consist of all 4 team bowlers scoring on the same night of entry during the same shift.
- 4. Each bowler must bowl in their respective divisions, by average, in Singles and all-Events. Total of all averages will determine the division for team and doubles events. The first two games bowled in any event by a bantam bowling in a 3 game event, will count toward all-events.
- 5. Report highest youth league average minimum of 9 games for Majors, Juniors, and Preps, and 6 games for Bantams, as of January 1, 2018. If not enough games bowled by that date, then use average as of January 26, 2018 with required number of games. Any USBC youth member who does not have an acceptable average may enter their respective division, but will receive no handicap.
- 6. All play will be on a handicap basis. 90% of the difference between the bowler's average and 230.
- 7. Teams and Doubles will bowl in the order listed on the entry blanks. Substitutions will be permitted only in the same lineup positions as the person they are substituting for.
- 8. ALL TEAMS, DOUBLES, AND SINGLES MUST REPORT 30 MINUTES BEFORE SQUAD TIME.
- 9. All entries must be received by the Tournament Manager no later than 30 minutes before the last squad on February 12, 2018. NO ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED UNLESS ACCOMPANED BY A CHECK OR MONEY ORDER made payable to the Helena USBC. There will be NO refunds. RULE #314 WILL APPLY.
- 10. One plaque will be awarded for every 6 entries or fraction thereof. All-Events plaques or scholarships will be awarded on the total scratch pins as well as scratch plus handicap. A bowler will only qualify in All-Events once, with scratch award being first. In the event of a tie, duplicate awards will be issued. PLAQUES OR SCHOLARHSIPS WILL BE AWARDED AS FOLLOWS: BY DIVISION IN TEAM, DOUBLES AND SINGLES. BY DIVISION, MALE AND FEMALE IN ALL EVENTS.
- 11. BOWLERS WILL BE HELD RESPONSIBLE FOR THEIR CONDUCT GOING TO, DURING, AND RETURNING FROM THE TOURNAMENT. ANY USE OF FOUL LANGUAGE, ABUSE TO EQUIPMENT, AND ANY OTHER CONDUCT OFFENSIVE TO THE BEST INTEREST OF YOUTH BOWLING WILL NOT BE ALLOWED.
- 12. THERE WILL BE NO MONETARY REWARDS DURING THE TOURNAMENT FROM ANYONE. RULE #400 WILL APPLY!!! THESE ARE SUBJECTTO SUSPENSION!!!!
- 13. The Tournament Manager and committee, whose decisions will be final, will decide any disputes. RULE # 329 will apply under Protests and Appeals. The current USBC Rules and Regulations will govern any rule not covered in the aforementioned rules.
- 14. All award fees will be returned in the form of plaques and scholarships for All Events winners.
- 15. <u>Dress Code</u>: Youth participants will not wear apparel or use bowling equipment depicting alcohol, tobacco, gambling, an illegal substance or inappropriate language/gestures during competition. Knee length shorts are allowed, appropriate dress must be worn, no hats. All final decisions regarding attire will be at the discretion of the tournament director. Penalty: First offense will result in a verbal warning and apparel change or removal of equipment. Failure to comply will cause the bowler's scores to be disqualified and the bowler to be removed from the competition.
