

2021 Helena USBC Women's City Tournament

Entry will be open to current adult female members of the Helena USBC Bowling Association.

The tournament shall consist of a four-woman team event, a doubles event and a singles event, and an optional handicap all events and optional scratch all events. Three consecutive games shall be bowled in each event, and the total pin count plus handicap shall determine the winners. The total pin count of nine games plus handicap shall determine the handicap all events winner. Handicap will be a three-game handicap.

**TEAM EVENT:** You may bowl as often as you wish with no more than two (2) USBC members competing together more than once.

**DOUBLES/SINGLES:** You may enter this event up to 3 times with a new partner each time. However, you will bowl both the Doubles and Singles event each time. Singles you can cash only once. Doubles you can cash multiple times.

This is an USBC handicap tournament. **Handicap will be based on 90% of a 220 average.**

**DIVISIONS:** Players will all be placed in one division.

Prize fees are returned 100%. Prize ratio will be at least 1 for 5 for Team, at least 1 for 6 for Doubles and Singles and at least 1 for 10 for All Events.

**No plaques or awards will be presented.** If there is a tie for first place in any event, the first and second place prize money shall be divided equally and duplicate emblems shall be awarded. If there is a tie for any other place in any event, the prize money shall be divided equally.

The tournament is open to women members of the Helena USBC Association **ONLY**. To be eligible to bowl in the city tournament a bowler must have been a member of the association for at least 30 days prior to the start of the HUSBC City Tournament, and have bowled at least 15 games in a HUSBC sanctioned league.

If a bowler is entered into more than one team, double, and singles event, **ONLY** their first team score in each event will count towards the All-Events total.

**Each bowler shall be responsible for submitting their highest 2019/2020 Year End Average (of at least 21 games).** If a bowler does not have a 2019/2020 Year End Average (of at least 21 games), they may use their highest January 1, 2021 Average (of at least 21 games). If a bowler has no prior year or January 1, 2021 average, they may use their highest current USBC average as of February 20, 2021 (of at least 21 games). All others may enter but will bowl without the benefit of handicap. **If a bowler's January 1, 2021 average (of at least 21 games) is 10 pins or higher than the prior season year-end average, the higher average will be used.**

Entry forms along with payment are to be submitted to Sleeping Giant Lanes or to a Tournament Coordinator. Reservations will be taken without payment but the money must be received within seven days of reserved shift time/date, or before you bowl, whichever occurs first.

Substitutes who meet the requirements of tournament rule #2 are allowed when replacement is necessary. The Tournament Manager should be advised of substitutes at least **ONE HOUR** before the scheduled bowling time, if possible. In case of disability after a game has started, a substitute shall be allowed, if one is available, in the team and doubles event only. The combined scores of both bowlers are to count in either of these events. Prize fund money to be awarded to the person whom starts that said event. If no substitute is available, only the actual score of the frames bowled shall be counted, zero for all frames after. (A substitute will not be required to reimburse the original entrant with the entry fee paid nor shall the substitute be expected to give the original entrant any prize money or trophy he/she may win.) The substitute will take the place of the original bowler in the lineup.

**Entries will close at 1:00 pm on February 28, 2021.**

**Summary:**

- 1. Tournament will be held two weekends, February 20<sup>th</sup> & 21<sup>st</sup> and February 27<sup>th</sup> & 28<sup>th</sup>, 2021.**
- 2. Multiple Team events can be played with NO MORE THAN 2 of the same players each time.**
- 3. Up to 3 Doubles events can be played with a different partner each time.**
- 4. Each time a person bowls the Doubles event, he or she will also bowl the singles event.**
- 5. Bowlers can cash in more than once in Team and Doubles event. However, only the highest score will count in the Singles event.**
